

VICE-CHANCELLOR VISITS LABORATORIES



SEPT 2, GAMBANG: The Faculty of Industrial Sciences & Technology (FIST) will be acquiring its own teaching and research laboratories within the year.

Vice-Chancellor, YH Prof. Dato' Daing Nasir Ibrahim would like R&D to remain highest on FIST's agenda.

In the present arrangement, FIST's pioneer intake of 57 Bachelor of Applied Sciences in Industrial Chemistry students receive laboratory instructions in the Faculty of Chemical & Natural Resources Engineering facilities. FIST graduate students and lecturers also conduct their research there.

The Vice-Chancellor during his scheduled visit indicated FIST should maintain its present research track record, become a leader in the fundamental sciences and help to spearhead the State's initiatives in Gambang.

The university, he added, will ensure adequate space and resources become available for such endeavors.
