

UNDERGRADUATES HELD A PROTEST AGAINST ZIONIST REGIME

It was a peaceful but significant gathering

About 500 Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) undergraduates held a rally at the compound of UMP Chancellery Building as a show of protest against the attack on Gaza, Palestine by the Zionist regime.

The rally was held from 5 pm until 6 pm on November 22, 2012 and organised by UMP Student Representative Council (SRC).

The gathering comprised undergraduates from various faculties and residential colleges including international students from Yemeni, Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Sudan.

They strongly condemned the regime's cruelty against the people of Palestine.

The group also handed over a resolution to UMP Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dato' Dr. Daing Nasir Ibrahim to be presented to

Prime Minister, Dato' Sri Najib Tun Razak.

According to SRC President, Abdul Na'em Suhaimi, 21, said they demanded that Palestine be declared as a sovereign state under the United Nations Organisation.
