A meeting on management of pest and disease infecting jackfruit variety in Malaysia was held at Jabatan Pertanian Negeri Pahang to overcome the problem of disease infecting a large number of commercial farms in Pahang. This disease called 'Nangka karat' had infected the Malaysian variety, Tekam

Yellow contributing to 80% overall loss in yield. The affected areas were Bentong, Bera, Jerantut, Raub and Temerloh. Faculty of Industrial Science and Technology, Universiti Malaysia Pahang has been requested to assist with soil and leaf samples analyses diagnose to the cause of this disease.
