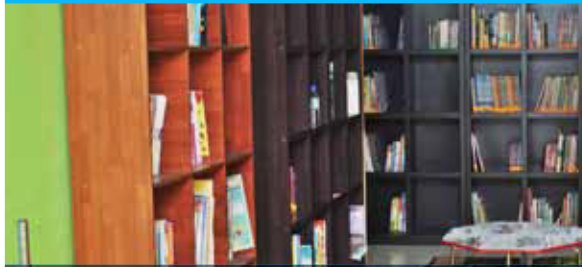


A Flying Success @ CAMAR
