"The other clusters are Student and Dependent Welfare Management, Student Termination Management and International Student Alumni Management," he said.

In addition, this meeting received feedback from the follow-up report of the visit by BEM and Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) in 2020.

Dato' Haji Shushilil Azam said this engagement session could improve collaboration and coordinate issues related to the management of international students.
