

104 RECEIVE PAHANG STATE AWARDS AND MEDALS

KUANTAN, Aug 4 (Bernama) – The Pahang state awards and medals are conferred on a total of 104 individuals in conjunction with the 64th birthday celebration of the Sultan of Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah.

The investiture ceremony will be held at Istana Abu Bakar, Pekan near here, today.
