Majlis Dekan-dekan Bahasa Universiti Awam (MaLDeC) and OMNiA Academy explore potential collaboration for educational advancement

PUTRAJAYA, 22 April 2024 - Key stakeholders from *Majlis Dekan-dekan Bahasa Universiti Awam* (MaLDeC) and OMNiA Academy Media Prima Sdn. Bhd. convened at the Ministry of Higher Education in Putrajaya.

Chaired by the Dean of the Centre of Modern Languages, Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA), Associate Profesor Dr. Nik Aloesnita Nik Mohd Alwi, the meeting aimed to explore potential collaborations to enhance educational opportunities and foster academic excellence.

Scheduled to take place in the University Sports Complex, UMPSA grounds on 9 November 2024, this event aims to elevate English language competency among public university undergraduates.

According to Ally, to bring university programs to the next level, promotion strategy is very important.

"OMNiA can help institutions to 'sexify' such program and popularise the program among educational institutions as well as the general public," he said.

The envisioned collaborations between OMNiA Academy and Malaysian public universities signify a paradigm shift in educational partnerships.
