## VC UMPSA speaks at China Conference (Heilongjiang) - Malaysia Higher Education Week 2024

DAQING, CHINA, 21 April 2024 - The Vice-Chancellor of Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA), Professor Dato' Ts. Dr. Yuserrie Zainuddin was invited to deliver a speech at the University President Roundtable Forum in conjunction with the China Conference (Heilongjiang) - Malaysia Higher Education Week 2024 which took place on 19 to 21 April 2024 at Northeast Petroleum University, Daqing recently.

He delivered a speech titled Fostering Innovation Through Educational Collaboration: Malaysia and China Partnership.

In addition to promoting UMPSA to higher education institutions in China, Professor Dato' Ts. Dr. Yuserrie shared the collaboration that has been established between UMPSA and educational institutions and industry in China.

"These programs are designed to meet the growing industrial demand in our country," he said.

He also shared the success of UMPISA in the UMPISA-Beijing Jiaotong University (BJTU) dual degree collaboration programme which is now expanded to China to pursue studies involving civil, mechanical and electrical engineering which will contribute to the development of the country's rail industry.

Also present were the Deputy Director-General of the Foreign Affairs Office Government of Heilongjiang, Li Shengbin, the Deputy Mayor of Daqing, Lu Jian Guo, the top management of Northeast Petroleum University and higher education and vocational institutions in Daqing.
