150 new students receive UMPSA Excellence Incentive

GAMBANG, 29 September 2024 – A total of 150 outstanding students, who have completed their diplomas, matriculation, polytechnic, Vocational College, or the Malaysian Higher School Certificate

(STPM), and were selected to pursue their studies at Universiti Malaysia Pahang Al-Sultan Abdullah (UMPSA), have been awarded the UMPSA Foundation Excellence Incentive for this academic session.

In addition, 30 students received the Educational Incentive Aid, and 12 students from B40 families were provided with laptops as part of the Laptop Assistance Programme to support their pursuit of undergraduate degrees at the university.
