

25 media personnel receive UMP aid

KUANTAN: Twenty-five members of the media in Pahang who were affected by the floods yet still carried on covering the situation received special aid from Universiti Malaysia Pahang (UMP) yesterday.

UMP Vice-Chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Daing Nasir Ibrahim said print and electronic media agencies had pooled together their resources and provided essential items for the victims.

"Although they were affected by the floods, they continued with their duties, including covering the flood operations and helping flood victims," he said after presenting the aid to the victims at the RTM Pahang headquarters here.

Daing Nasir said UMP had also sent its volunteer teams, comprising its staff members and students, to help flood victims clean up their homes and villages.

He said UMP had also set up an action committee to coordinate volunteer teams from other public and private institutions of higher learning that arrived to help flood victims in Pahang.
